1. Roll-Call for Participants & Congress

- 12 member countries out of 16 member countries were present.
 - Hong Kong, D.P.R. Korea & Tajikistan were absent.
 - Kazakhstan was absent at the ASF congress, but present at the FIS congress.
- Quorum met
 - Opening of the congress was announced.

2. Greetings (Welcome Speech by Dr. Sung-Won Lee, President, ASF)

First of all, I do welcome all of you, congress participants from ASF member countries to the 12th ASF Congress, coinciding with the 48th FIS Congress here at High 1 Resort, Kangwonland Hotel, Gangwon Province, Korea. It is meaningful to note that this is the first FIS Congress in Asia in the 100 years of FIS history, therefore this is eventually the first ASF Congress in Korea also. Personally, I have been deeply involved with staging the FIS Congress at the Kangwonland Hotel in Korea. I am very happy to have you all here and I do hope you would enjoy staying at Kangwonland's fresh new International Convention Hotel with all sorts of good meetings, activities and fruitful results.

All the programs of the Congress are to take place under "one roof" of the congress hotel, where all the necessary activities are totally contained. Differing from normal congress schedule, all the dinners for the one whole week are set as invitation dinners every evening. That's why normal practice of after-congress ASF dinner has to change to an after-congress luncheon. This time, our FIS being the first big important customer to the Kangwonland's International Convention Hotel, the hotel has tried best to accommodate FIS family at their utmost. It will be a significant "Thursday Excursion" to have a trip to Alpensia town of PyeongChang which is the ski sports cluster of 2018 PyeongChang Winter Olympic Games about 50 km due north of Kangwonland Hotel.

The 20th Asian Alpine Championships (Children) was staged at High 1 Resort (the ski resort area of Kangwonland Hotel) in Mach 2011. I know that some of you already visited the Kangwonland Hotel at time of the event. It was nice to have had one of the best accommodation at the High 1 hotel.

We had a big participation of 13 member countries with 81 racers and 21 foreign coaches and officials. The Kangwonland Hotel paid a special attention and consideration to the event because of expecting 2012 FIS Congress to come, for which I am very grateful. The latest championships was the 21st Asian Alpine Championships (Juniors) which was held in Dizin ski resort of Iran in late February 2012, with participation of 68 racers and 19 foreign coaches and officials. The significance of this championships was the fact that ASF staged Super-G, Super G Combined for the first time in an Asian Alpine Ski Championships.

Although the terrain of ski courses was very challenging for Super-G and GS, all the competition runs were carried out successfully. Personally, I was very impressed with the entire ski resort terrain of Dizin, beautiful snow and nature, which made me and Iranian Ski Federation talk about many constructive views, ideas and issues how we can best use of such a wonderful ski mountain for speedy development of upgrading Asian ski, particularly alpine ski. This aspect of discussion will be taken up in Agenda item 5. Discussion, 5-1 Iran, based on Iranian proposal letter.

As a matter of fact, this issue is such a big and broad problem. Therefore, I don't think we can come out any solution in conclusion right away. However, it is worthwhile to consider that now we take note of such a perspective and think about stepwise future approach and strategy. Also this time, we have some interesting proposals from few member countries and we will review under the item of discussions. I hope we will have a good congress meeting today. However, I shall be available at your disposal as far as my schedule permits. Once again, I thank you for your kind participation to this Congress and do hope for your enjoyable and meaningful stay.

3. Acceptance of Official Minutes of the 11th ASF Congress

The minutes of the 11th ASF congress in in Antalya, Turkey on June 2nd, 2010 were unanimously accepted. The minutes had been circulated to member countries on July 16th, 2010 and there were no other comments.

4-2 Report on the 20th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in Korea in 2011

During the 20^{th} Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) held at the High 1 ski resort in Korea on March $4^{th}-5^{th}$, 2010, the 13 countries (HKG, IND, IRA, JPN, KAZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, PAK, TJK, TPE, UZB) were participated.

Here, the High 1 resort was the site for the 48th FIS congress in 2012, therefore big participation was made. It was the best hotel in history of Asian Alpine Ski Championships. It was regrettable that Kyrgyzstan could not participate this time unfortunately because of their visa problem. Dr. Lee hoped that Kyrgyzstan would participate by all means.

4-3 Report on the 21st Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in Iran in 2012

Iran Ski Federation briefly explained about the 21st Asian Junior Alpine Ski Championships which was held at Dizin ski resort in Iran. The 10 countries (IND, IRA, KAZ, KOR, MGL, NEP, PRK, TJK, TPE, UZB) were participated. 4 disciplines (SL, GS, Super G, Super Combined) were taken place.

Iran Ski Federation would like to have a training program especially for Super G and Super Combined because this kind of terrain of Dizin ski resort would be a challenging training piste for racers to develop and upgrade their skills.

5. Discussions

5-1 Iran

Iran Ski Federation had proposed an agenda for congress for conduction of continental cup in West Asia Area and expressed such a discussion in Dizin was confirmed by Dr. Lee, president of Asian Ski Federation. Dr. Lee explained that above mentioned is grossly misleading and such an issue of establishing a FIS Continental Cup – West Asia Cup is not anything Dr. Lee could confirm. He pointed out it is clearly under the jurisdiction of FIS Continental Cup Sub-committee. There were some discussions about big level-up and development alpine skiing capacity in West Asian region utilizing such an excellent and challenging alpine slopes of DIzin, particularly in alpine speed events.

For the 21st Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) held at Dizin, it was the first time for Asian Championships to conduct alpine speed events (SG, SG Comb.) and it was very successful and clearly demonstrated great benefit of the excellent SG course and natural environment of Dizin. We discussed that Dizin could be a great site for West Asia as intensive alpine training center, particularly for speed events. There, in long future we might be able to consider independence of West Asia Continental Cup Sub-committee when alpine ski level of the West Asian region becomes sufficiently high enough.

As shown in the table of "An Analysis on FIS Point Distribution for Some Member Countries" (East Asia – West Asia) (Attachment 9), West Asian countries (IRA, KAZ, UZB, LIB) definitely needs faster development of alpine ski level, particularly middle to elite level. Thus, we only talked about and hoped for possibility of West Asia Continental Cup Sub-committee in long future when all the conditions are met. Therefore, it is too premature and grossly misleading to even hint the conduction of West Asia Continental Cup Sub-committee at this time.

It was also mentioned that a plan of special alpine training camp at Dizin should be formulated by Iran for middle to elite alpine competitors of West Asian region countries, inviting special best coach with the help of FIS under FIS solidarity program. When Iran comes up with such a project formulation, Iran is to submit to ASF for a study and review.

5-2 Nepal

Nepal's request special training for Junior athletes by ASF for ski developing nations, which countries do not have international standard ski resort, was well noted. Similar situation can exist with some other underdeveloped ski member nations without proper domestic ski resorts.

Best current solution is formulating and joining regional ski camps at neighboring ski resort country. For Nepal, there is good neighbor India which is very active in various levels of alpine ski camps. A good collaboration of India and Nepal is highly required and it is hoped to have a good resulting future.

The proposal of implementing the Asian Alpine Championships as prototype of the World Championships once in 2 years or once in 4 years so that any athletes who have FIS Code can compete with no limitation of their age. It is well noted as a very fresh proposal. Only issue is financing aspect of conducting a new category alpine championships. It is well accepted and decided to share the current system of alpine ski championships.

The current system is alternating 2 alpine championships (children and junior). Now, we decide to add the "<u>Licensed" (above Junior I)</u> category; just, Alpine Championships (Men or Ladies). Therefore, now we have 3 categories; Alpine Championships (Children), Alpine Championships (Junior), and Alpine Championships (Men or Ladies), and turning around every 3 years.

5. Comments:

- (1) The High1 resort is the site for the 48th FIS Congress in 2012. For this reason, big participation was made from 13 ASF member countries with 46 foreign racers and 31 foreign coaches/officials. There was the largest number of foreign officials since the Asian Alpine Ski Championships. Especially, two presidents of Hong Kong and Nepal (Mr. Edmond Yue, president, Ski Association of Hong Kong and Mr. Jeevan Ram Shrestha, president, Nepal Ski Association) participated.
- (2) A lady racer, Camilla Trapness from Hong Kong got a bronze medal in SL (Children II). She was only racer representing Hong Kong and her mother was the coach. Camilla was trained by her mother in U.S.A. for some months in order to achieve a good result at this game. Her father also participated as a referee in GS at this championships. This is the first time for Hong Kong to obtain a medal in the Asian Alpine Ski Championships since they became a full member of ASF in 2004. They said that they would issue a press release.
- (3) From Iran, the biggest group of 10 racers and 5 coaches/officials participated. The 21st Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) are to be held in Iran next year, therefore quite a number of Iranian delegation came here as learning process for a better execution of next championships in Iran in 2012.
- (4) It was notable that Lebanon got 3 medals (2 Silver, 1 Bronze) this time unlike last year. There were no medals for Lebanon at the 19th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in Almaty, Kazakhstan in 2010. In addition, three parents of three Lebanese racers participated to observe this game and the High1 resort.
- (5) Kyrgyzstan submitted their entry, however, they could not participate this time unfortunately because of their visa problem.
- (6) As the ASF member countries experienced the High1 resort for the first time through this game, Nepal and Chinese Taipei expressed their opinions wanting to have a ski training camp for their racers at the High 1 resort next season in 2012. Chinese Taipei is already contacting the marketing team of High1 resort and negotiating a special arrangement for their accommodation and racers' training program.
- (7) Mongolian team c ould manage to participate at this championships by arriving at the High 1 resort early in the morning on the very day of championships because they succeeded in getting a visa just one day before the championships.

5. Comments:

- (1) The 21st Asian Alpine Ski Championships was held at Dizin ski resort where is located in central Alborz Mountains, 150 km north of Tehran, Iran. It takes 2 hours by car from Tehran, 3 hrs from Theran International airport. Dizin Resort started officially in the winter of 1969.
- (2) The longest run from top to bottom is 7.5 kilometers, considered as the longest skiable run in the Middle East. The ski season in Dizin runs from mid-November until late April and/or early May, with cold but mostly sunny climate. During the summer season, Dizin resort offers grass skiing, and every year, FIS Grass Skiing World Cup races are held in Dizin.
- (3) The length of the Gondola from the base to the top of the mountain is 3700 m. The highest ski lift reaches 3600 m, making it one of the 40 highest ski resorts in the world. The highest peak in Dizin is Mt. Damavand with the elevation 5610 m at east of Dizin. Hotels at base area are situated at altitude of 2500 m.

- (4) There are no snow cannons to make artificial snow. Dizin is completely covered with only natural snow. The temperature on the slopes during the championships was -16°C. In the cold but beautiful sunny weather, racers could enjoy their competitions.
- (5) It was really a successful championships which included SG and Super Combined for the first time in an Asian Alpine Ski Championships on such a challenging mountain and alpine pistes which ranges between 2500 m – 3500 m elevation with totally complete white snow without any trees.
- (6) Dr. Sajjadi (Deputy Sport Minister of Iran), Mr. Mohammadi (Governor) and Mr. Montaghani (President of Sport Ministry in Alborz Province) participated at the opening ceremony. One prize giving ceremony for Super G, Super Combined and GS took place at a grand assembly hall of the hotel, and another prize giving ceremony for SL took place on the slope right after the SL competition.
- (7) Dr. Sung-Won Lee, president of Asian Ski Federation suggested that top 10 ranked racers in the championships should be trained in the challenging pistes of Dizin, especially for Super G and Super Combined under special training program. Therefore, Dr. Lee advised Iran Ski Federation to initiate a training program because this kind of terrain of Dizin ski resort would be perfect training piste for racers to develop and upgrade their skills.

Iran is to request FIS Solidarity to render financial support for such special training programs for speed events under a special coach assigned by FIS. Iran will also come up with more with speed events Asian ski competition programs in future.

- (8) Iran performed the best, obtaining 10 gold medals out of 16 available, achieving Nation's Cup, rank1st. Iran was really jubilant, for which they deserve.
- (9) A lady racer from North Korea got a mild injury on her wrist in the GS competition, but she did not give up next day's competition and completed SL competition with a splint on her injured wrist.
- (10) Kyrgyzstan intended to participate at the Asian Alpine Ski Championships for the first time. However, they cancelled at the last minute because of their racer's sudden illness.
