Special Guest Speech: (Mr. Gian-Franco Kasper, FIS new-president)

I am happy to attend at the 5th ASF Congress Meeting on today and to greet all of you as member of ASF Country. ASF has been conducted his important role in the stage of International Skiing Development.

Following the decision of last 40th FIS Congress, FIS and Dr. Sung-Won LEE, one of the Working Group Members have established "FIS Aid and Promotion Program" which is to have beneficial effects for ski development of Asian region.

We will endeavor to promote skiing and increase the number of skiers to worldwide and to intensify cooperation between FIS and ASF.

Once again, I would like to express my appreciation to your kind cooperation and ASF effort for global skiing development.

2. Greetings by Chairman(Dr. Lee Sung-Won, President, ASF)

The 41st FIS Congress of 1998 being staged in the heart of the Central Europe this time here in Prague. I am very much delighted to see more attendance by Asian Ski Federation member countries, unlike the last Congress at the distant Christchurch, NZE. I am sincerely welcome all the delegates of Asian Ski Federation's ski families to the 5th Asian Ski Federation Congress here in Prague and I appreciate very much for your large attandance to this Congress, particularly because this FIS Congress seems to be a very important one.

Since the Christchurch, the 2 years period for ASF have been fairly difficult one. The 7th Asian Junior Alpine Championships to be sponsored by Chinese Taipei based on leasing a Korean Ski Resort in early 1997 was suddenly cancelled by the proposed organizer. However, it was fortunate to reschedule the Championships by Korea at the Phoenix Park Resort of Korea early March 1997. However, once again, the 8th Asian Children's Alpine Ski Championships scheduled for March 15-17,1998 at Tottori Prefecture, Japan, was suddenly cancelled at 9 days prior due to warm weather and lack of snow. It was simply unfortunate the effect of the world famous El Ninjo hit our schedule and we were compelled to cancel the program itself. We understood well that the 1998 was also hard and busy year for Japan in making the '98 Nagano Olympic and Para-Olympic to a success under such a unfavorable weather. I congratulate Japan for success of '98 Nagano Olympic with such a flooding of world and Olympic records. There was another occasion of cancellation of a schedule, which is the cancellation of the site '97 summer ASF Council Meeting in Lebanon due to some changes in the National Association.

On the other hand, during the time, ASF achieved some important cooperation linkage with FIS for tangible financial support to our ASF Championships and other ski developing activities. Under FIS Aid and Promotion Program directed by Gian-Franco KASPER, together with European ski developing nation group. ASF is exploring possibilities of various financial supports for ski developing member nation to promote develop their level of ski.

During Jan. 30-Feb.7,1999, we are to have another gala event in ASF territory; the 4th Asian Winter Games in Kangwon/Yongpyong, Korea. I look forward to having your cooperation and support to make the Games succussful. I sincerely hope to have better and wider range of cooperations and friendships among ASF members and closer cooperations with FIS in future.

I thank you, once again, for your attendance to this Congress and wish each National Ski Association for the continued success and prosperity, expecting to see your attentive support and initiative to the future development of ASF. I wish you all to have a pleasant and fruitful stay here at the beautiful and European classic city of Prague.

The Congress discussed 2 topics about Marketing Committee and Children's Game

- -To activate the activities of Marketing Committee, Mr. Ha Kong-Sang, Chairman, to complete the forming of committee members. Japan will nominate a person who is going to be member of ASF Marketing Committee after the SAJ General Assembly and Mr. KIM Chung-Kun is nominated by Korea as a member of Marketing Committee. The new development of activities will be from time to time reported to President for consultation and discussion.
- -A future program under FIS Aid and Promotion Program is to be sought to select a limited number of top talented children racers(say, winner of Children's Competitions) and to train them intensively in a leading children's racing school under total FIS support.

On behalf of all ASF member countries, I would like to give him my gratitude for his dedication for the ski development of Asian ski nations. I and all of Asian Ski Families support Dr. Lee as a new-president of ASF for next term.

-LEBANON-

Dr, Lee Sung-Won is re-elected as new President of ASF for 98-2000

China Ski Association recommended new vice-president Mr. Xiao Tian, President of China Ski Association, in steady of Mr. Feng Jianzhong.

-Mr. Rajinder Kuma Gupta expressed his president's message before going on to the election of director. This is summary of his message. "On behalf of Mr. Kurma, president of Winter Games Federation of India, I would like to explain the india's ski development situation. We have several new skiing resorts with modern facilities. We are going to host international ski competition under FIS recognized as soon as possible.

Surely, we are improving so rapidly to high quality and technicque. Winter Games Federation of India request ASF Congress to give them a quota of Vice-president or Director of ASF Board Member."

(Mr. Rajinder Kuma Gupta, IND)

-Thank you very much for your message. I do understand your viewpoint. First of all, because Winter Games Federation of India is Associated Member Country of FIS, I would like to ask you let me consider your request after becoming an Ordinary Member of FIS. As a matter of fact, I now you have a good chance to become an ordinary member of FIS at the FIS Congress this time. I suggest to take up your inquiry, after you obtain your ordinary member status, even at our next Council Meeting. (Chairman)

According to the ASF art 6-3 and to fill the 3 vacancies we have now in 8 directorships, Vladimir Solokin of Kazakhstan, Nassim Khalil of Lebanon and Vladimir Lysov of Uzbekistan recommended as new Directors. Congress unanimously agree to appoint 3 additional director among the member countries. Korea Ski Association recommended Mr. Chang Soo-Wong in place of Mr. Kim Ha-Yoon.
